



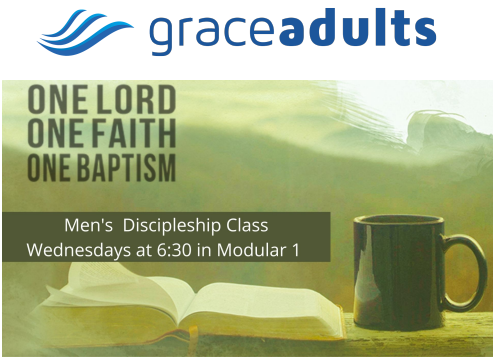
A SCOUT IS REVERENT

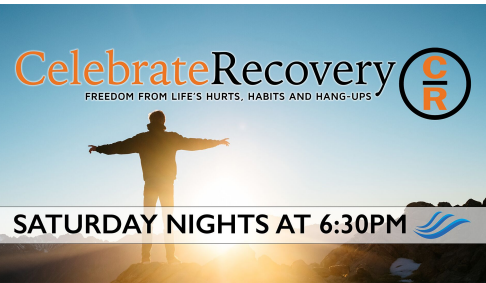
