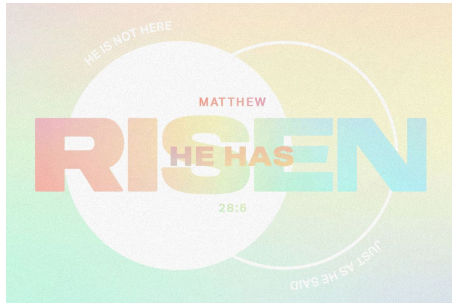


MIDWEEK ACTIVITIES
