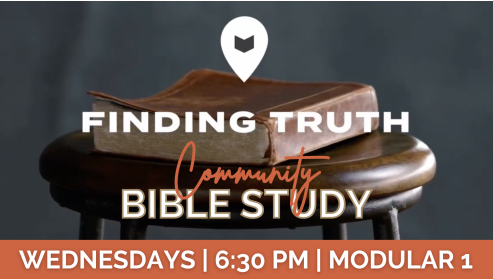

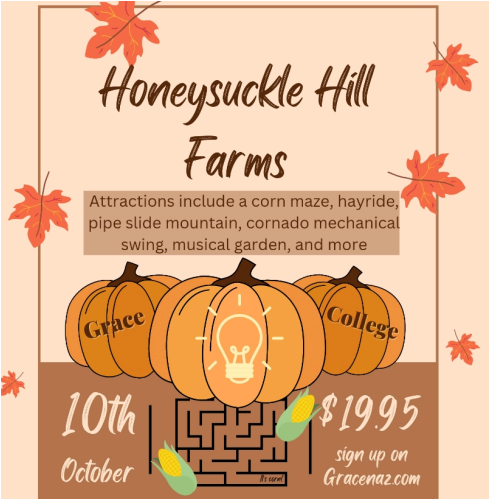
- THE GATHERING:** meets in Room 6 at 6:30pm for a time of reflection into God's word and prayer.
