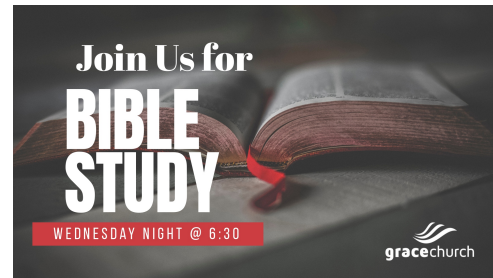
Grace Church welcomes Awaken to our worship service today!
