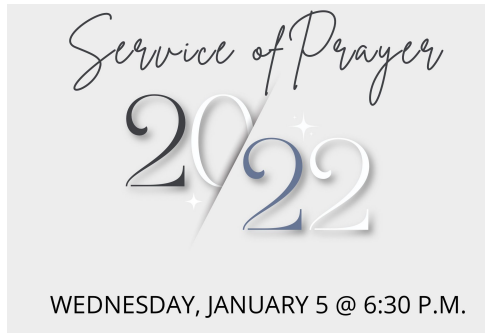
We will be collecting clean coats and blankets throughout the month of January. All donation benefit the City of Refuge. Donated items can be placed in the bin located under the carport.

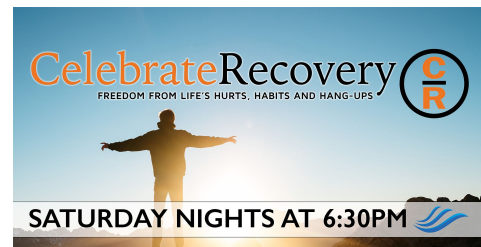
