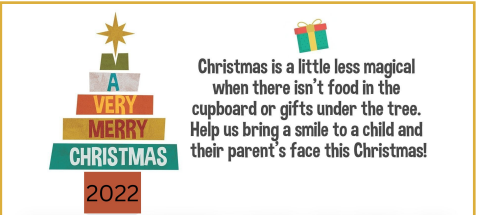




You're invited to join us around the table after service today for our annual all church Thanksgiving dinner located in the Family Life Center.
